2015 Predator Scholarships

The Eric Usjak (company) Memorial Scholarship

Amount \$1,000

The Eric Usjak Memorial scholarship is awarded in the memory of former Predator Erik Usjak to a predator player who exhibits the following criteria:

- Is eligible and has applied to a community college, university or apprenticeship program for the 2015 school year;
- Demonstrates outstanding community service with preference given to work with the Canadian Mental Health Association or one of its affiliates;
- Demonstrates compassion, empathy on and off the football field.

The Brandon Nickel (company) Memorial Scholarship

Amount: \$1,000

The Brandon Nickel Memorial scholarship is awarded in the memory of former Predator Brandon Nickel to the predator player who exhibits the following criteria:

- Is eligible and has applied to a community college, university or apprenticeship program for the 2015 school year;
- Demonstrates the importance of morals and values consistent with a respected member of our community and exemplifies these qualities in his/her daily life;
- Demonstrates outstanding community service.

The Kyle Griffiths Memorial Scholarship

Amount \$ 1,000

The Kyle Griffiths Memorial scholarship is awarded in the memory of former Predator Kyle Griffiths to a predator player who exhibits the following criteria;

- Is eligible and has applied to a community college, university or apprenticeship program for the 2015 school year;
- Demonstrates outstanding community service with preference given to work with the Canadian Mental Health Association or one of its affiliates;
- Demonstrates compassion, empathy on and off the football field;
- Preference will be given to an offensive or defensive linemen.

The Kathy Mason Founders Scholarship

Amount: \$1,000

The Kathy Mason Founders scholarship is awarded to the predator player who exhibits the following criteria:

- Is eligible and has applied to a community college, university or apprenticeship program for the 2015 school year;
- Demonstrates leadership and excellence both on and off the field;
- Demonstrates a true love for football and a dedication to the Predators program;
- Demonstrates altruistic qualities: puts the Predator Team's, fellow players and coaches needs before his/her own needs.

The Twin Cities Predator Award

Amount \$1,000

The Twin Cities Predator award is presented to the predator player who exhibits the following criteria:

- Is eligible and has applied to a community college, university or apprenticeship program for the 2015 school year;
- Demonstrates excellent athletic abilities and football skills;
- Demonstrates that he/she is a team member supportive of his/her fellow players, coaches, parents and Twin Cities executive;
- Displays respect for himself/herself and others in a manner that is exemplary to others;
- Demonstrates his commitment to the Predator Program and displays exemplary dedication through his attendance at practices, games and other functions.
